Eligibility:

In order to be eligible for Federal Work Study, students must:

- Submit the FAFSA and complete all verification requirements
- Demonstrate financial need
- Be in good academic standing and meet satisfactory academic progress requirements
- Be enrolled in at least 6 credits per semester at Reynolds
- Meet all federal financial aid eligibility requirements
